## **Coral Morphologic**

The Coral City Camera (CCC), created by art-science duo Coral Morphologic, is an underwater camera streaming live from an urban reef in Miami, Florida. Located along the shoreline at the east end of PortMiami in about 10 feet of water, Coral City Camera provides a fish-eye view into the urban marine ecosystem that has developed around the human-made shorelines of Miami. For *Coral City Camera* @*MIA*, a selection of the camera's views at their very best are screening at MIA*mi* - Miami International Airport *moving images* video project - showing travelers that Miami has a vibrant Marine ecosystem of its own and an incredible biodiversity living just below our city's waterline.

The CCC is a public art and scientific research project by Coral Morphologic produced with Bridge Initiative and Bas Fisher Invitational as a part of WATERPROOF, a series of site-specific artists' projects developed in direct response to the environmental issues facing South Florida.
