PROCESS FOR ANY APPLICATION CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION OF AN AERONAUTICAL LANDING AREA

- 1. Proponent sends form 7480-1 Notice of Landing Area Proposal to the FAA.
- 2. Proponent receives letter of acknowledgment from the FAA.
- 3. Proponent checks with local zoning for any aeronautical landing area restrictions.
- 4. Upon receipt of a FAA letter (can start collecting FDOT required information earlier), proponent contacts FDOT by applying on their web site for site approval.
- 5. There is a 45 day waiting period. If there is no opposition to the proposal, after 45 days, the proponent must register the landing area with FDOT by using their website at <u>www.florida-aviation-database.com</u>. Proponent must re-register every 2 years thereafter.
- 6. FDOT issues site approval letter (by e-mail).
